- IV. Special Guest, Kristin Schweiter, HMS School Improvement Specialist. Kristin presented on Student Engagement focusing on student absenteeism. She suggested checking out schoolquality.virginia.gov website, which shows "school report card" on any school. Absenteeism has been steadily growing so school is looking at how to bring that down Looking for universal supports such as creating an engaging school climate, building positive relationships, communicating the impact of absences on achievement, monitoring chronic absences, recognizing good and improved attendance, identifying and addressing barriers. Kristen asked for ideas to reward students who are present 5 days a week. We discussed a weekly drawing. We also discussed a drawing for perfect monthly attendance and possibly perfect attendance for the year as well. Karen recommended allocating \$50 to support the attendance program from the PTSA School Programs line item.

- VIII. Principal's Report, Dr. Ellison: The Hawk Hike was wonderful. Dr. Ellison has heard nothing but great things about the event. The line dancing went well.

Report cards went out. Dr. Ellison noted families can check the Flight Plan for more info on events and happenings. She also mentioned that there are two more upcoming forums with information about redistricting.

IX. Committee Reports

- a. Hawk Hike, Karen Talley: The Hawk Hike brought in \$8,100, a considerable increase from last year. Karen noted the following as contributing to the success: 1) she did all the legwork for the sponsorship requests and 2) the marketing started earlier this year. Last year 127 students contributed and this year 154 contributed-66 in 7th grade, 63 in 6th grade and 25 in 8th grade. Karen added prizes for the top three fundraisers per grade. In the past, just the top fundraiser per grade received a prize. All who contributed \$25 or more will get a HMS tumbler. Suggestions: Start early for marketing, fundraising, sponsorships and raffle prizes and make sure there are enough raffle prizes to keep the students interested at the awards ceremony.
 - This year there was line dancing instead of rotations and that was well received. Karen requested teacher input about the best day of the week to hold the event and about activities that seem enjoyable to most students. Friday seemed to work well and the activities at this event seemed to work well.
- b. Spirit Nights, Karen Talley: Next Spirit Night is Thursday, December 7th at Chick-fil-A on Mooretown Road. It will be a competition with Toano. There will be a flyer coming out next week.
- c. Membership, Jodie Davis: We have 384 members. Jodie thanked faculty and staff for signing up. Membership cards will be mailed to all who signed up.
- d. Mini-Grants, Karen Talley: There were 15 mini-grants requests totaling \$4,800. All were funded by PTSA and HMS. We might offer another mini-grant program. More information will be shared at a later date.
- e. Reflections, Alisa Smith: 26 students submitted Reflections entries with a total of 34 entries. 6 first place entries have been submitted to District. Check the Flight Plan for a list of winners. All participants were recognized at the Hawk Hike and Dr. Ellison thinks we should continue to recognize participants at the Hawk Hike.
